

KADENA OFFICERS' SPOUSES' CLUB Scholarship Application 2021-2022

PURPOSE:

To acknowledge outstanding military dependents within the Kadena AB community by offering financial assistance towards education in any field of their choice. In previous years, the KOSC has provided numerous merit-based scholarships up to \$3,000.

ELIGIBILITY:

Scholarship applicants must:

- 1. Be a 2021-2022 Graduating High School Senior or Dependent
- 2. Be seeking an undergraduate or graduate degree at an accredited vocational, two- or four- year college or university **OR** technical / vocational school
- 3. Have current Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA) status
- 4. Be a dependent of a sponsor who is **ONE** of the following:
 - Active duty or Retired U.S. Air Force personnel (Officer or Enlisted)
 - U.S. Military, civilian, or DoDEA personnel assigned to or living on Kadena AB
 - Current KOSC member
- 5. Have a minimum 2.5 GPA in high school or college coursework
- 6. Have NOT been awarded a KOSC scholarship in the past

Factors considered in selection include scholastic achievement, extracurricular activities, community service, job or volunteer work experience, evidence of leadership ability, teamwork, educational and career goals, and composition skills. This merit-based scholarship will be awarded without regard to gender, race, or creed of applicant, school attending, rate or rank of sponsor, or financial status.

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS:

Successful applicants will be awarded scholarship funds not to exceed the cost of one-year's tuition and fees.
 Scholarship monies may be used to pay for tuition, room and board through the educational institution (excluding spouse winners), academic fees, and books. Scholarship payments that exceed the balance owed to the institution for the above categories will be returned to KOSC.

3. KOSC scholarships will be paid to the winner's designated academic institution and mailed directly to that school - institution must be able to accept American dollars in the form of a check. Scholarship recipients will receive a copy of this correspondence to the address we have on file.

4. Military academy appointment, full ROTC scholarship, full scholarship award (that covers 100% tuition, room, board, books, and fees), or non-acceptance by college or failure to attend will make an applicant ineligible. 5. Awarded scholarships not activated by September 30, 2021 will automatically be canceled. The KOSC Executive Board may consider exceptions to this rule if notified in writing. Scholarships are not retroactive or renewable.



POLICIES:

1. The KOSC Scholarship Committee determines the number of scholarships and the monetary value of each scholarship based on available funds, the number of applicants, and the analysis of applicant composite scores. Submission of an application does not guarantee a scholarship. The total amount awarded varies from year to year depending upon the amount of funds the KOSC has raised.

2. All applications are scored by an independent panel of judges. Complete anonymity of applicants will be preserved during the selection. Judges and their family members are ineligible for scholarships.

3. KOSC Scholarship Committee members and their dependents are ineligible for scholarships.

4. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Failure to follow all directions may result in disqualification.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. A complete application must include the following:
 - \checkmark Completed application sheet with signed statements of applicant and sponsor
 - ✓ Official copy of your transcripts from high school or college (including final grades for the most recently completed semester) including spring semester 2021). Unofficial transcripts (those that do not have the official school seal or are opened) will not be accepted. Transcripts emailed directly from the school to kadenaosc.scholarship@gmail will be accepted.
 - ✓ Typed Essay Question (Part I) AND typed Goal Statement (Part II)
 - ✓ Typed Resume (Part III)
- 2. DO NOT include your name or identifying comments on essay questions or resume as your application will not be accepted. The application sheet is the only place you may disclose your name.
- 3. The application will be accepted as complete and valid ONLY when ALL of the required documents are submitted in a single envelope (**DO NOT** staple any of the documents together). Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- 4. Scholarship applications may be dropped off at the Kadena Gift Corner during business hours, listed below, no later than April 8th, 2022 at 3:00 p.m..
- 5. When your complete application is received for processing, you will be notified via email.

NOTE: All responses should be typed using 12-point font and double-spaced Remember your essays and resume should have no identifying information (including your name).

Part I: Essay Question

Choose one of the following essay questions. Your essay must be 250-500 words.

- Describe how your leadership ability contributed to your greatest personal achievement at school, work, on the field, or in your community.
- Graduating Seniors: What does being a "Third Culture Kid (TCK)" mean to you and how has living overseas influenced you? (Coined in the 1950's by Ruth Hill Useem, TCK refers to people raised in a culture different from their parents or different from their country of nationality. Being a TCK comes with a unique set of strengths and challenges that other individuals may not experience.) OR Dependents: How has your military lifestyle impacted you?

Part II: Goal Statement

An essay of your educational and career goals. Your goal essay must be 250-500 words.

Some areas you may consider addressing include:

- What do you want to do after you graduate from college/technical school?
- Why did you select this career?
- How will you change the field/industry?
- Where do you see yourself 10 years from now?
- How have your past experiences led you to this educational/career path?

Part III: Resume

A one- or two- page typed resume of activities, community service, honors, awards, and work experience.

Some areas you may consider including:

- High schools you have attended, their locations, and date of graduation (if applicable).
- Any college or university you attended or are currently enrolled in. Please indicate dates of attendance and list any completed degrees or certificates.
- Awards or honors you have received including dates and name of the organization granting the award. Extracurricular activities by year, describe your role, and identify any offices held if applicable.
- Community volunteer activities or work experience, including dates, especially those reflecting your personal and educational goals and interests.
- Please include any other information you feel is relevant to your scholarship application.
